ERGT Recommended Skills & Knowledge

There are no pre-requisites for this course, however in order to complete this training within ERGT's course duration it is recommended (but not mandatory) that trainees; are experienced workers that are in fulltime or part time employment. The trainee should be familiar with workplace hazards associated with tasks covered by permits and related hazard controls.

Trainees should be able to:

- Understand verbal and written work instructions
- Communicate with team members about routine operations
- Recognise that a permit is required before commencing work
- Plan and organise their own work
- Monitor and adapt to changing work situations
- Work effectively with others
- Recognise emergency situations and act appropriately
- Identify tools and equipment appropriate for a task

This course is delivered using classroom presentations, group discussions, practical demonstrations and exercises. Trainees will demonstrate their competence through written and practical assessment.
