# FOET – FURTHER OFFSHORE EMERGENCY TRAINING

ERGT Australia's OPITO Further Offshore Emergency Training course covers helicopter safety and escape, fire fighting, self-rescue and emergency first aid.

## Learning Outcomes

The expected learning outcomes for this course are:

- Demonstrate, in a simulated environment, that they can use the safety equipment and follow procedures in preparing for and during helicopter emergencies – with particular focus on escaping from a helicopter following ditching.
- Demonstrate that they can use basic firefighting equipment effectively, and use self-rescue techniques in low visibility and completely obscured visibility situations e.g. smoke filled areas.
- Demonstrate that they can perform basic firstaid.

The FOET is open to persons who have a valid (in date) OPITO approved BOSIET (with CA-EBS), T-BOSIET (with CA-EBS), T-BOSIET, T-FOET, T-FOET (with CA-EBS), BOSIET, FOET (with CA-EBS) or FOET.

## **Additional Requirements**

A current offshore or industry equivalent medical is required for this course. Please see the Medical Form document on [ergt.edu.au](http://ergt.edu.au) for a list of accepted medical clearances.

## **Structure & Assessment**

90% of this course is delivered through practical trainee participation, activities and discussion in a simulated workplace environment. The remaining 10% is delivered as theory in a classroom. Trainees will demonstrate / explain / identify their level of knowledge, skills and understanding through written assessment and practical activities.
