Distance learning



- Consult with key industry stakeholders and our clients to determine what is a 'fit for purpose' approach to training during COVID-19
- Wherever possible develop effective alternate delivery methods for the essential 'License to Operate' competency outcomes for our clients
- Reduced number of any personnel on site at any one time and ensure we avoid any non-essential group interactions

Fit for work



- Self assessments and declarations are used to identify any person who is at risk of contracting or transmitting COVID-19
- All trainees, visitors and employees are required to complete a self-declaration prior to arriving at any ERGT facilities
- Self declarations and temperature screening checks are completed upon arrival to an ERGT facilities

Stop the spread



- Our social obligations require that ERGT maintains all appropriate measures that ensure any risk of spreading COVID-19 is ALARP
- Eliminate any potential for surface based transmission with effective and maintained hygiene and sanitisation controls
- Reduce course size, strict physical distancing practices, tracing trainee movements and altered training practices to ensure social distance requirements are adhered too

Rapid response



- Developed effective solutions for the sanitation of any ERGT site in the event of an exposure to a confirmed Covid-19 carrier
- Measures in place to determine where any confirmed case has been and manage the exposure areas and facilities
- Provide assurance that any ERGT facilities has been decontaminated following any exposure to a confirmed case
