## ESSO OCCUPATIONAL FIRST AID

The purpose of this course is to provide trainees the skills and knowledge required to work confidently and respond to a first aid incident in the role of Primary First Aider on an Esso Australia worksite. The course content covers CPR skills, oxygen provision, the management of a range of injuries and conditions, triage and injury prioritisation and the provision and maintenance of first aid resources in the workplace.

Additional content to nationally recognised outcomes, includes company specific equipment and procedures including the provision of medications under the instruction of the company doctor.
