OCCUPATIONAL FIRST AID SKILL SET UPGRADE ESSO

The purpose of this course is to provide current Esso Primary First Aiders who hold HLTSS00027 Occupational First Aid Skill Set, with updated units of competency from the HLT – Health (Release 7.0) training package.

This course refreshes the skills and knowledge required to work confidently and respond to a first aid incident in the role of Primary First Aider on an Esso Australia worksite. The course content covers CPR skills, oxygen provision, the management of a range of injuries and conditions, triage, and injury prioritisation.

Additional content to nationally recognised outcomes, includes company specific equipment and procedures including the provision of medications under the instruction of the company doctor.
